

The Good Samaritan

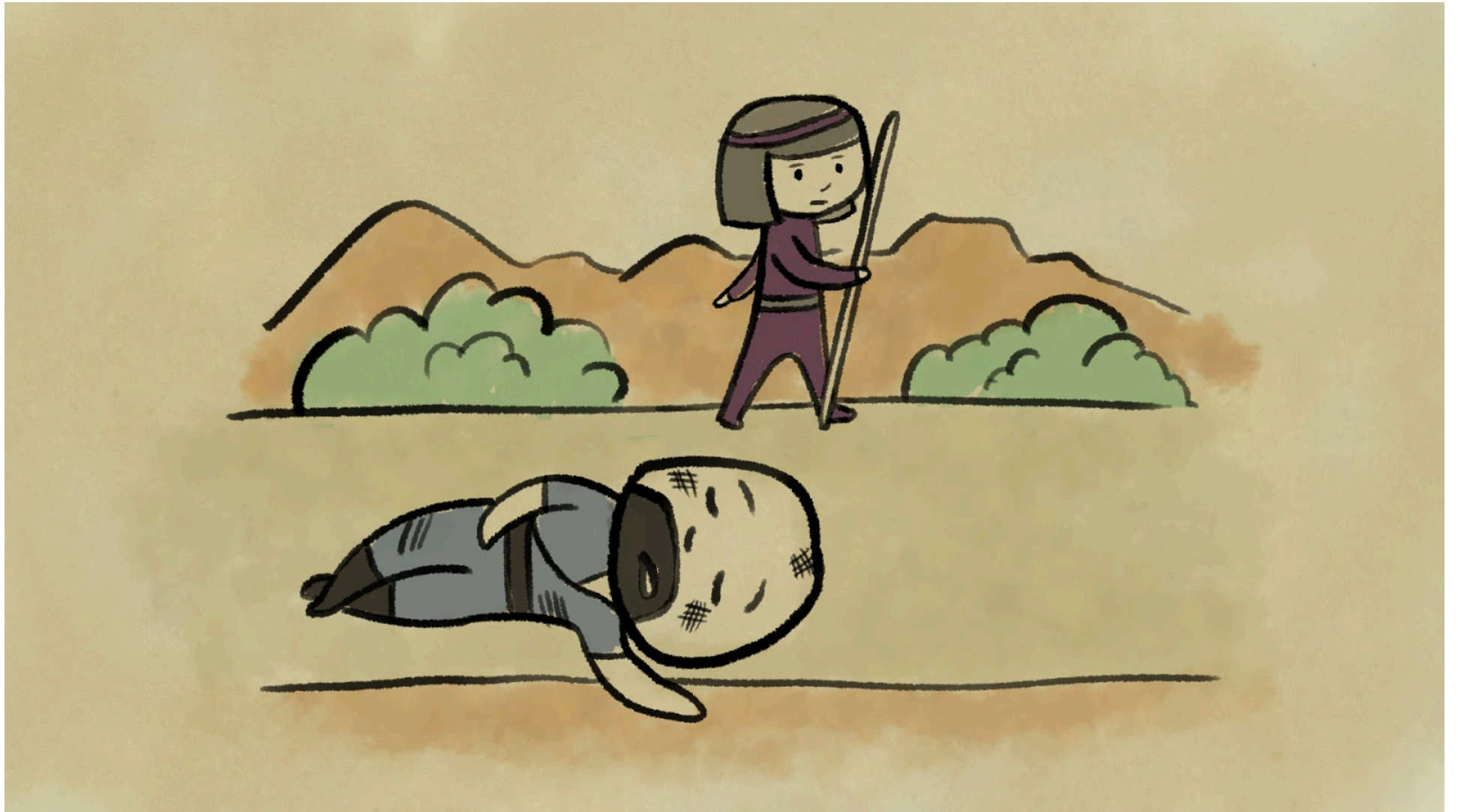
Luke 10:25-37

(Point to the man walking on the road)

One day a man was walking down the road on a long trip. While he was walking, some mean people attacked him.

Let me hear you say, “Oh no!” (Everyone will say, “Oh no!”)

Oh no is right! The mean people beat him up, stole his clothes, and left him lying on the side of the road. He was so hurt that he could not move!



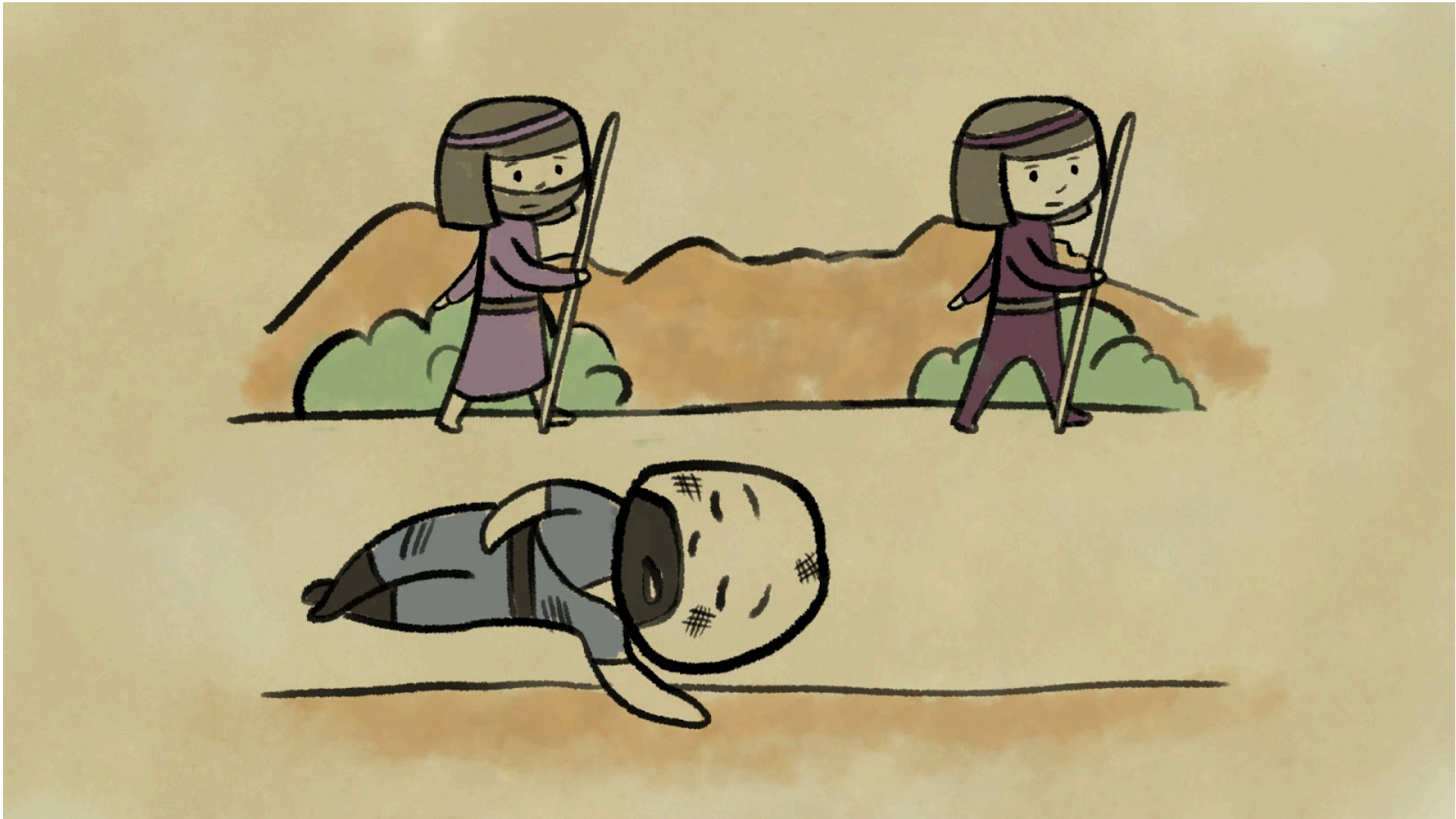
The man needed someone to help him!

Everyone hold up one finger. (Everyone will hold up one finger)

The first person to come down the road was a church leader.

Do you think the church leader will help the hurt man? (ALLOW responses)

Well, when the church leader saw the hurt man, he crossed to the other side of the road and kept on walking. He did not even stop to help!



Now let me see you hold up two fingers. (Everyone will hold up two fingers)

Very soon, a second (SHOW two fingers) church leader came by.

Do you think this church leader helped the hurt man? (ALLOW responses)

When he saw the hurt man lying there, he crossed to the other side of the road and kept on walking, too!

Let me see you hold up three fingers. (Everyone will hold up three fingers)

The third (show three fingers) ***person to come down the road was a man from a faraway town, called Samaria.*** (Pronounced: Suh-mair-ee-uh)

The Samaritan (pronounced: Suh-mair-ih-ton) ***man saw the hurt man and stopped to help him. He gave him some bandages to help him feel better. He also put the hurt man on his donkey and took him to a nearby inn, where he could be taken care of.***

Do you think Jesus wants us to be like the two (show two fingers) ***men who walked by the hurt man or like the Samaritan*** (pronounced: Suh-mair-ih-ton) ***man who helped the hurt man?*** (The Samaritan man)

Yes! Jesus tells us that we should be like the Samaritan (pronounced: Suh-mair-ih-ton) ***man and show love to others!***

Let me hear you say this after me: (Pause to allow kids to repeat)

I Can (thumbs to chest)

Show Love (hug self)
